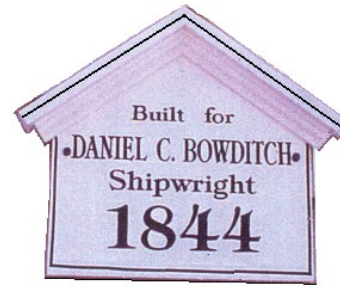


Historic House Plaque Program

Specifications:

Dimensions: Approx. 12" wide x 12" high

Materials: ½" MDO weatherproof maritime signboard: 2 coats of oil-based primer, finished with 1 coat of oil-based enamel. Edges are resin-sealed and double-coated. Picture molding frame representing roof peak.

Hardware: Holes are pre-drilled and (2) 2 ½ inch coated wood screws are provided.

Color: White background with black lettering

Research: Documentation of age of home required and certified by the Foxborough Historical Commission.
